

Tigers UNLIMITED Donor Agreement

Donors agree to adhere to and abide by rules and regulations concerning intercollegiate athletics determined by the NCAA, SEC, and Auburn University.

Should questions arise concerning the various rules and regulations, donors acknowledge that they should contact the Auburn Athletics Department Compliance Office/334-844-9887.

Donors agree that should they be found by the NCAA or the University to have violated, knowingly or without regard for the same, rules or regulations they may be dissociated from the University, athletic program, and its activities. Donors can be expelled as a member of Tigers Unlimited and will forfeit all benefits and privileges thereunto (including the right to receive priority season tickets and parking at specified athletic events) until the end of the period of dissociation and subsequent reinstatement by Tigers Unlimited.

TICKET Orders

Ticket orders are taken after priority contributions are received. Tigers Unlimited baseball donations are due by September 1. Upon receipt of your contribution, ticket order forms will be e-mailed in December. TAX Information

Section 170(1) of the Internal Revenue Code sets values for university ticket priority payments. Twenty percent is allocated to the ticket priority and 80% is a charitable deduction. If other benefits ("amenities") are covered by the payments, such as tickets, concessions, programs, parking passes, or donor events, the value of these must first be deducted from the payment, and the balance is 80% tax deductible. Based on the number of home games and other factors, the amenities value can vary each year. Tigers Unlimited operates within the Tigers Unlimited Foundation, tax ID 36-4538203, which is a public charity listed in IRS Pub. 78, Cumulative List of Organizations. An official tax receipt will be issued by the Foundation. Major gifts or contributions not associated with ticket priority are 100% deductible.

DONORS PLEASE NOTE: Problems may arise when TUF contributions are made by entities other than individual donors due to the donor benefits. Employer matching gift funds, donor advised funds, community foundations, and other private charitable foundations can pay only tax-deductible portions of contributions. If you anticipate requesting a gift from one of these sources and have any questions about the amount that is not tax-deductible, please call Janie Boles at (334) 844-1153.

GENERAL Information

IMPROVING SEAT LOCATION

The Tigers Unlimited seating priority program for baseball is based on a person's total contribution to baseball. Should you desire to improve your ticket location, you must submit your request when you order your season tickets on-line from the ticket office.

SITTING TOGETHER

Persons ordering season tickets who wish to sit together should submit their request on-line when ordering their season tickets. When filling these orders, the priority used by the ticket office will be that of the lowest priority of the group.

ACCESSIBILITY

TICKET PRIORITY TRANSFER POLICY

Tigers Unlimited Fund (TUF) contributors' tickets and priority can only be transferred to their spouse at the time of death. The tickets and priority cannot be passed down to future generations.

LOST, STOLEN, OR DESTROYED TICKETS

Tickets obtained from sources other than the Auburn Ticket Office could be lost, stolen, or counterfeit tickets and, if so, may be seized and cancelled without compensation. *TICKETS WILL NOT BE DUPLICATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.* The Auburn Athletics Department reserves the unrestricted right to revoke tickets by refund of purchase price.

REFUND POLICY

The Auburn Athletics Department reserves the unrestricted right to refund any portion of the order due to lack of availability of tickets. Deposit of your payment is NOT a guarantee that tickets are available to fill your order.

PROMOTIONAL TICKETS

Auburn Athletic tickets may not be used for advertising, promotions (including contests and sweepstakes), or other trade purposes without the express written consent of the Auburn Athletics Department.

TO RENEW:

PLAINSMAN Park

The site of Southeastern Conference baseball excitement since 1950, Samford Stadium-Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park was voted the best collegiate baseball facility in the country by Baseball America prior to the 2003 season.

Plainsman Park seats 4,096, including 3,227 chair back seats. In addition, state-of-the-art concessions, restrooms, ticket and press facilities have transformed Auburn's baseball field into a renaissance of Camden Yard proportions.

The structure also houses the Tigers' clubhouse, which features a locker room, training and equipment areas, an indoor hitting tunnel, a team lounge area, coaches' offices and umpire dressing room.

The design combines the look of old-time ballparks with academic buildings on the Auburn campus to create a façade of brick and painted steel.

In 1997, the field was named in honor of Billy and Jimmy Hitchcock, brothers who became two of Auburn's most noteworthy athletic performers during the 1930s. In 2003, Auburn University renamed the facility Samford Stadium-Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park after W. James "Jimmy" Samford, Jr., a key player in helping convert Plainsman Park into arguably one of the best baseball facilities in the nation.

The Auburn baseball team not only has the luxury of practicing and playing in one of the nation's top collegiate baseball facilities, but it has access to a weight room that is unrivaled in college baseball.

Adjacent to Plainsman Park, the weight room is located on the first floor of the 13,274 square foot Strength and Rehabilitation Center that was completed in January 2003.
